WHAT WE DO

Formed in 1998, Hudson Link for Higher Education in Prison provides college education, life skills and re-entry support to incarcerated and formerly incarcerated men and women to help them make a positive impact on their own lives, their families and communities, resulting in lower rates of recidivism, incarceration and poverty.



HISTORY

Prior to 1994, there were more than 350 college programs inside U.S. prisons. In 1994, Congress abolished Pell Grant eligibility for incarcerated persons, which provided nearly all funding for these programs. As a result, all but 8 college programs nationwide shut their doors. Based on powerful evidence that education transforms lives, reduces recidivism and creates a positive ripple effect in communities, Hudson Link is the only 501(c)3 non-profit in the US run by formerly incarcerated individuals to provide college degree-track programs in prison.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Sean Pica, Executive Director of Hudson Link for the past 12 years, is a nationally recognized expert on prison education. Under his leadership, Hudson Link has grown from a 65-student college program operating inside one prison to over 600 students enrolled in both college preparatory and college programs at five New York State correctional facilities.

College Preparatory

Hudson Link's college preparatory program is designed to meet students at their current academic levels and prepare them for the challenges and rigors of college level study. This is accomplished by offering preparatory classes in core disciplines of English, Math, Sociology and History.

College

In collaboration with accredited institutions of higher learning, Hudson Link's college program is the core of our endeavors. Partnering with Columbia University, Columbia-Greene, Mercy, Marymount Manhattan, St. Thomas Aquinas, SUNY Sullivan, SUNY Ulster & Vassar Colleges. Hudson Link sponsors Associate and Bachelor's degrees in Behavioral Science, Liberal Arts and Organizational Management.

College Completion

Hudson Link established The College Completion Program to provide released Hudson Link students who were unable to fulfill their degree requirements while incarcerated, the opportunity to complete degrees that they began at various on-campus locations.

Alumni Services

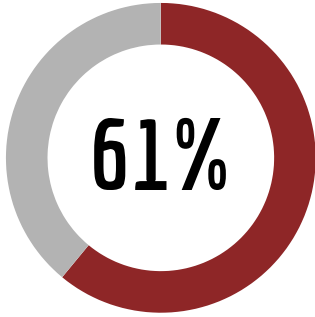

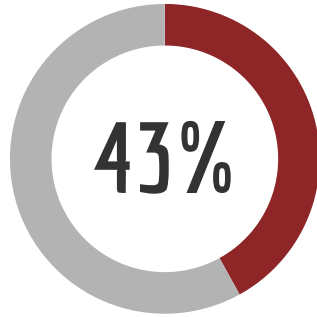


NYS INCARCERATED PERSONS WITH <8 YEARS OF EDUCATION



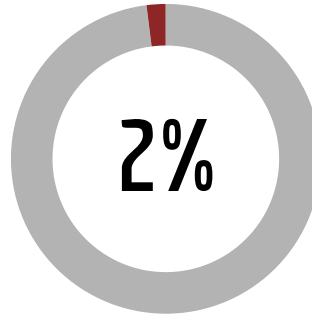
This number is dramatically influenced by the alarming fact that in excess of 20% of incarcerated men and women are entirely illiterate prior to entering prison.

NEW YORK STATE RECIDIVISM



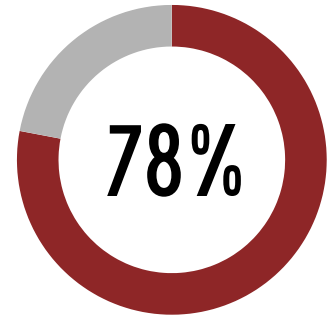
In New York State, 43% of men and women released from prison will return within 3 years.

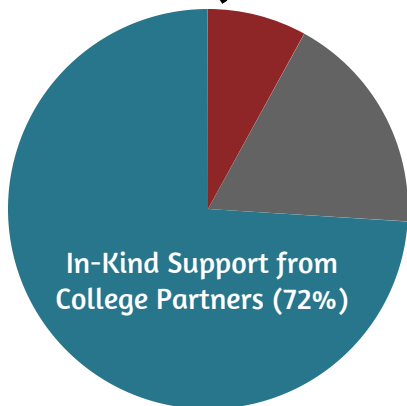
